NUNNEHI: The "Running Spirit" area, just under the foot ball, has been designed with the proper amount of flex, cushion and energy return to promote correct strides reducing foot fatigue.



FIS: First Impact Spoiler on the rear lateral portion of the heel corrects the stride landing, brin-

ging the foot to its natural position sooner when contacting the ground, li miting shocks and relative plantar fasciitis traumas.

UNRHELL: Our internal heel shell counter shape offers lateral support and is scalloped on the calcaneus area, minimi-

zing the contact area, which in conjunction with the extra soft lining helps preventing Achilles tendonitis.

on the second lace permits lower tension on the second metatarsal area promoting blood circulation even during the longest sessions.






